

POSTDOCTORAL POSITION  
at the Mathematical Institute of BME

The Mathematical Institute of the Budapest University of Technology and Economics invites applications for one- or two-year limited term postdoctoral appointments at the Assistant Professor level beginning September 1, 2016. The number of available positions are subject to budgetary approval.

The applicant should have a PhD in Mathematics obtained in 2013 or later. Preference will be given to candidates working in a research area which is recently active in our institute. However, outstanding candidates from any area will be considered. Selection will be based upon the candidate's research record and potential. The position is open to candidates of any nationality who may have a Hungarian working permission.

The teaching load of the successful candidate will be equivalent to three, two-hour courses per semester (two semesters a year) and supervising undergraduate students in at least one semester. Taking part in the scientific life of the Institute is also expected.

Salary will strongly depend on the excellence of the applicant. The net amount will be appropriate to cover accommodation and all other usual local expenses; it will be paid in HUF (Hungarian forints). In each year, an additional 300 000 HUF (approximately 1000 euro or 1100 USD) stipend will be available to cover research related costs (such as attending conferences, buying books or IT accessories, etc.).

- The name and e-mail address of at least one reference who can comment on your research skills,
- A survey on your previous research (maximum 2 pages),
- A working plan about your research for the next one or two year (maximum 2 pages),
- The list of your publications,
- Please indicate, that you are applying for a one-year or a two-year position.
