Receiving the Shanti Swarup Bhatnagar Award, Council of Scientific and Industrial Research, from Prime Minister Nehru, India on March 23, 1963

"The country's need at present is greater than mine," Prof. Radhakrishna Rao said here today, donating Rs 10,000 to the National Defense Fund. Prof. Rao, head of the Research and Training School of the Indian Statistical Institute, had been given the money as the Shanti Swarup Bhatnagar Memorial Award. He said he considered the Award more as recognition of the importance of the science of statistics than of his work. "And I feel happy," he added.
